

Destination Overview

Historic and hip, charming and chic, Providence, Rhode Island combines the best of a quaint New England town with the amenities and sophistication of a larger city. The city's downtown is compact and filled with innovative and eclectic restaurants, a vibrant arts and culture scene, and preserved historic architecture.

The Rhode Island Convention Center (RICC) is situated in the heart of downtown, where attendees can step out of their meeting and walk to dinner or a touring Broadway show within minutes. On one side, the RICC is connected to the 564-room Omni Providence Hotel and Providence Place, a popular shopping destination. On its other side, the RICC is connected to the 14,000-seat Amica Mutual Pavilion, the area's premier multiuse events arena. Events may also be held nearby at The VETS, a 2,011-seat historic theater located across from the striking Rhode Island State House.

Some of the nation's top schools call Providence home, including Ivy League Brown University, world-renowned Rhode Island School of Design, and Johnson & Wales University, a leading culinary educator. The presence of these educational institutions infuses the city with a youthful vibe.

TRANSPORTATION

- The Providence/Warwick area is a 60-minute drive from Boston and a three-hour drive from New York City, both via I-95.
- The Amtrak station is located within easy walking distance of the RI Convention Center and most downtown hotels. The station also offers commuter rail transportation to Boston and to Rhode Island T.F. Green International Airport in Warwick.
- Rhode Island T.F. Green International Airport's InterLink facility offers scheduled rail service to Providence and Boston, and includes a consolidated rental car facility and bus transportation
- Boston's Logan International Airport, the 18th busiest airport in the nation, is less than 50 miles from Providence. Logan offers nonstop service to 70 U.S. cities and 30 international destinations.
